

Discontinuity and Non-Projectivity: Using Mildly Context-Sensitive Formalisms for Data-Driven Parsing – Errata

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The purpose of this document is to correct an error in our paper *Discontinuity and Non-Projectivity: Using Mildly Context-Sensitive Formalisms for Data-Driven Parsing* (Maier and Kallmeyer, 2010) and to deliver a clarification.

- The third and fourth column in Tab. 4 are partially swapped. The corrected table is as follows:

- The numbers of non-terminals for the grammars extracted from the dependency version of NeGra and the Prague Dependency Treebank (922, resp. 51 non-terminals) refer to the unbinarized grammars and are for this reason not reported in Tab. 1. Tab. 1 only contains the number of labels of the binarized and markovized grammars.
